#### Surface preparation

Remove oil and grease, etc...with PROFESSIONAL DEGREASER. Remove salt and other contaminants by high pressure (minimum 250 bars) fresh water hosing. When the surface is dry: abrasive blasting to SA 2,5 according to ISO 8501-1 with a surface profile corresponding to Medium G according to ISO 8503. If sandblasting is not an option, sand back the metal surface using a grade 24-36 up to St3 surface preparation standard with a 50-75 surface roughness. After blasting clean the surface carefully from abrasive and dust. Clean thorougly and allow to dry completely.
